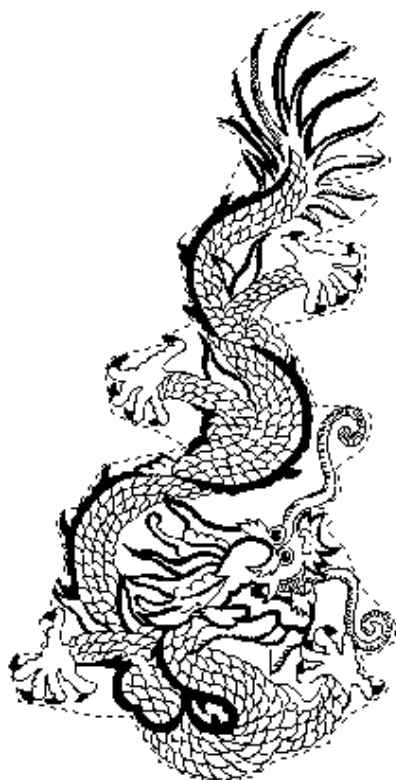

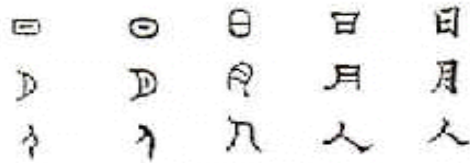

About the Courses

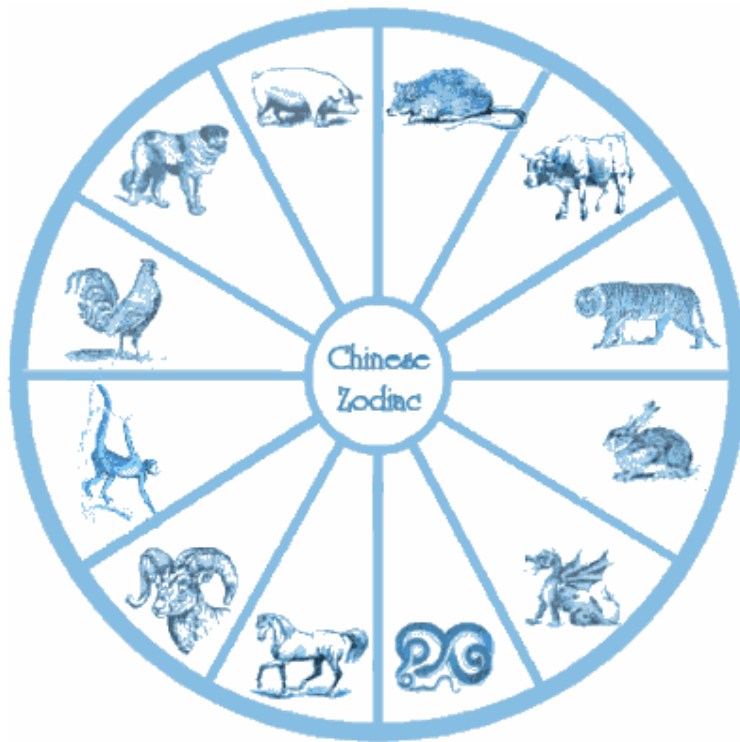
Twilight Club (3:30-5:30, as a precursor to the GCSE course or just for enrichment.
